## Village Board Meeting Minutes November 28, 2023

The Village of Caledonia Board of Trustees held a Special Meeting on Tuesday, November 28, 2023 at 6:00 p.m. at the Village Office.

In attendance: Mayor Scott DiLiberto, Deputy-Mayor Jerry O'Donoghue, Trustee Janet Cappotelli, Trustee Sarah Santora, Trustee Dorothy Grant-Fletcher, Working Foreman Chris Buckley, Town Council member Quentin Clark, Marshal Oberer and community members.

Trustee Cappotelli led the meeting to start plans for the Kick-Off to the Solar Eclipse Event. The event will be held on Friday, April 5<sup>th</sup> at Washburn Park on the village tennis courts. 5-7:30 pm will be kid activities. The goal is to educate the public on the eclipse, increase family involvement, provide solar glasses and work with local businesses. The Caledonia Fire Department will be working with the Fair Grounds on Saturday until Monday. The eclipse glasses will be available at the town and village clerk offices beginning on March 1<sup>st</sup>. Village residents will go to the village office for up to 4 glasses. Town residents will go to the town office for up to 4 glasses. Mayor DiLiberto will mail letters to neighbors in the Washburn Park area detailing which roads will be closed. The band Shine has been reserved for the evening and will play from 7:30 pm to 11 p.m. Donations are being made by four businesses to cover the costs of the band. Quotes have been received for the tents/tables. McCartney quote \$12,000, Capp Tents \$2,600. Heaters will be donated, propane needed and porta potty quotes are coming in now. Section V is \$1,700-\$2,000 depending on how many will be placed in the business district on Saturday and Sunday. A cornhole tournament is being discussed.
